**The Goa, Daman and Diu (Repeal of Posts and Telegraphs Laws) Regulation, 1962
No. 8 of 1962**

Promulgated by the President in the Thirteenth Year of the Republic of India.

A Regulation to provide for the repeal of certain laws relating to Posts and Telegraphs in the force in the Union Territory of Goa, Daman and Diu.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 240 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Regulation made by him:-

1. Short title extent and commencement. - (1) This Regulation may be called the Goa, Daman and Diu (Repeal of Posts and Telegraphs Laws) Regulation, 1962.

(2) It extends to the whole of the Union Territory of Goa, Daman and Diu.

(3) It shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1962.

2. Repeal of laws relating to Posts and Telegraphs. - As from the commencement of this Regulation, the laws specified in the Schedule shall stand repealed.

3. Savings. - The repeal of any law by Section 2 shall not affected-

(a) the previous operation of such law or anything duly done or suffered thereunder;

(b) any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under such law;

(c) any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against such law;

(d) any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment as aforesaid;

And any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed as if such law had not been repealed.
